



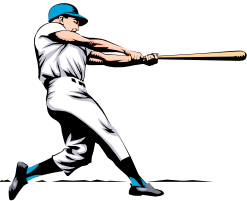
The Fun Doesn't Have to End!

The Trail Blazers are a parent-child group that meets for monthly fun activities both nearby and far away. We don't meet monthly in family houses and are not grouped into tribes; We don't wear vests and go on snake dances. Trail Blazers are coed. Trail Blazers participate in more young-adult family activities. Trail Blazers involve parents and their children together in a wide variety of activities and events. PROGRAM DIFFERENCES

In Y-Guides/Princesses there are many activities kept brief and varied due to the short attention span of younger children. In Trail Blazers, older children are involved in more challenging activities that require greater manual dexterity or strength, or a longer attention span.

MEMBERSHIP

- Membership to the Trail Blazers is open to any parent by doing the following:
- Join with a child between the suggested ages of 9-13, or grades 4-8. Note; some kids participate well into their high school years!
- Register using the Lake Prairie Federation Registration Process
- Pay the annual Lake Prairie registration fee for the first child and \$10 additional for children 2, 3, etc. If there is a younger sibling in the Y-Adventure Guides program, then there is only a fee of \$10 for each additional child in any of the Y-Adventure Guides or Trail Blazer programs.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- To have fun!
- To strengthen the bond of communication between parent and child.
- To help the parent and child to develop a growing sense of trust, love and mutual respect as the child's needs for independence increase.
- To nurture the child's personal development - emotionally, physically, mentally & spiritually - and to support the child in achieving a secure relationship with peers.
- To aid the parents in understanding their changing role as a parent model.
- To foster a healthy family, relationship among parents & children and family groups, striving to strengthen family life and communications.
